

HARTFORD CITY MISSION :: STREET LEADER :: SUMMER 2016

Hartford City Mission will hire Junior Camp Counselors, called “Street Leaders”, to help our summer interns with a elementary school kids summer program, called Camp Noah, serving children in the North End of Hartford.

A Street Leader’s job is to primarily love the kids at Camp Noah. Other work obligations include building positive relationships with kids, setting up camp, leading activities like crafts, games, and songs, keeping kids on task, disciplining kids, and participating in skits.

You are eligible to apply for the Street Leader position if:

- You are over the age of 16
- You have come to Young Life at least 2 times this 2015 – 2016 school year
- You are legally eligible to work in the United States
- You are finished with school and/or are able to start working on Monday, June 13th

Details of Street Leader work schedule:

- Street Leaders will work four hours a day (12:30 pm – 4:30 pm), five days a week (Monday – Friday), **starting June 13th and ending July 27th**. All Street Leaders are also expected to attend one or two pre-camp training meeting prior to starting work at Camp Noah (dates to be determined).
- Street Leaders will be paid \$9.60 hourly for 20 hours a week for those weeks.
- Street Leaders will also have the opportunity to engage in enrichment activities with HCM’s summer interns and other Street Leaders outside of Camp Noah/work hours. These will include hangout sessions and a once a week brunch. Street Leaders will not be paid for these hours but are required to attend.
- Additionally, as a representative of Hartford City Mission, the Street Leader is expected to live as an exemplary role model in all areas of their life. All Street Leaders will be evaluated bi-weekly by HCM staff on their Job Skills, Attitude, Teamwork, and Leadership.
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Expectations for Street Leader Applicant:

- You must love God and be actively seeking to grow in your faith.
- You must enjoy working with elementary aged children and be a positive role model.
- Your lifestyle outside of work must match the example you set during work. Among other things, your Facebook/Twitter and all social media pages must represent this clean, professional, Christian attitude.
- You must be able to use positive verbal and non-verbal affirmation with children, adults, and co-workers. No negative communication towards children or staff including name-calling, making fun of, or having a negative tone of voice or overall attitude is acceptable.
- You must be able to work on a team, cooperating with and encouraging your co-workers.
- You must be able to resolve all conflicts with other staff quickly and make an effort to communicate well with supervisors and other staff.
- You must respect the authority of all other staff.
- You must enthusiastically engage in all activities during work hours (arrive on time, stay to the end, no breaks for phone calls, etc, without the approval of your supervisor).
- Absolutely no displays of verbal or physical violence threats, no participation in illegal activities, no illegal substances, and no weapons.

- Once hired, Street Leaders will sign a contract further detailing work responsibilities and expectations. Failure to comply with those expectations will result first in a meeting with your supervisor, second in a deduction in your pay, and finally in firing.
